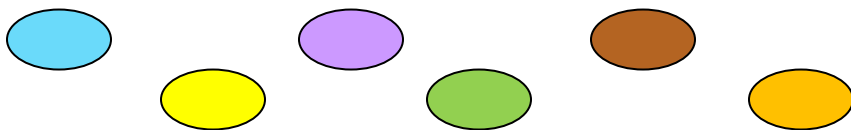

TREE PLANTATION

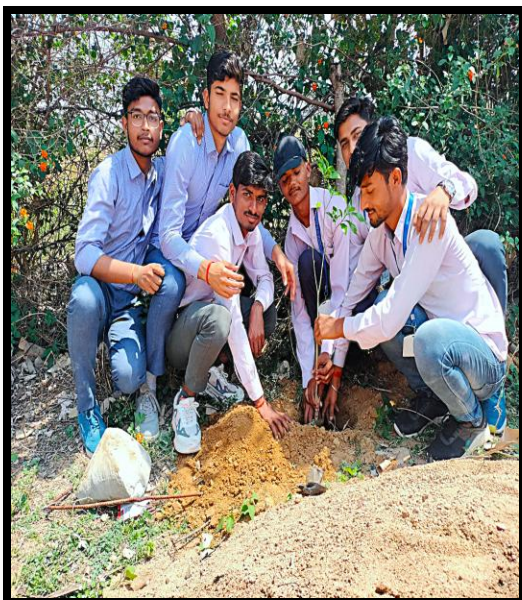

ENTREPRENEURSHIP TRAINING PROGRAM

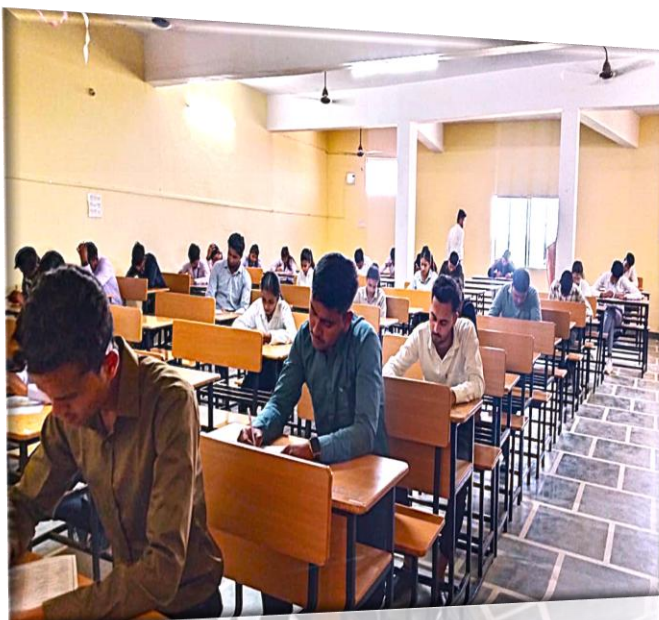
